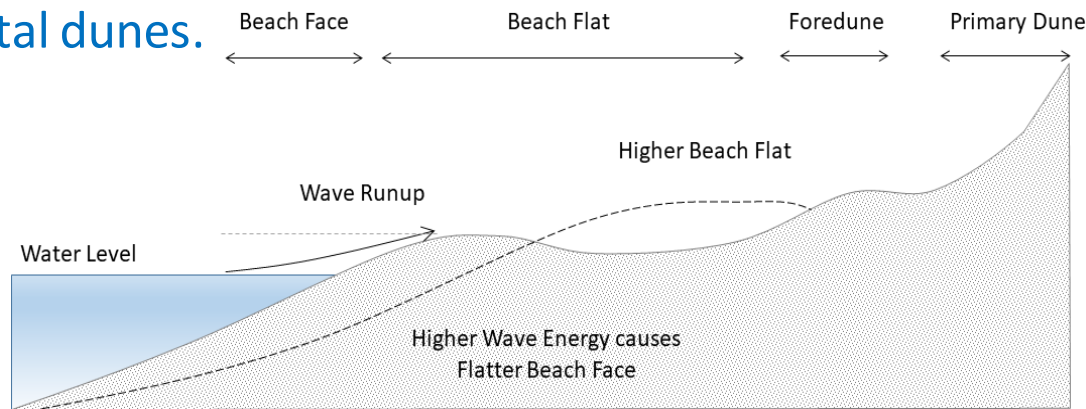
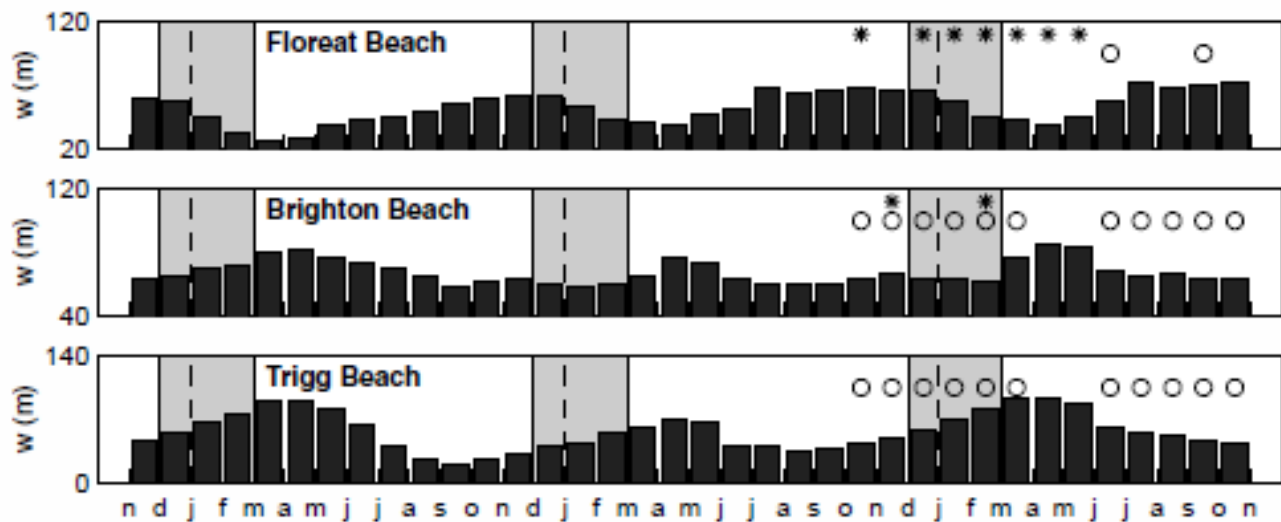


Sediment Cells and Storm Impact

The beach flat provides a crucial buffer to storm impact on coastal dunes.



Sediment cells have been defined based on observed patterns of seasonal alongshore sediment transfer.



For the south-west, early season impacts usually occur near the southern boundary of sediment cells (e.g. Cottesloe, Floreat)
